Leadership & Supervision

- Provide 24-hour supervision to campers in both bunk rooms and during field activities.
- Lead and supervise camp activities, ensuring camper safety, engagement, and enjoyment.
- Foster a positive, inclusive camp environment by maintaining high standards of behavior and discipline.
- Serve as a positive role model by displaying maturity, responsibility, flexibility, and sound judgment.

Surf Instruction & Education

- Lead surf lessons, teaching campers ocean safety, surf etiquette, and wave dynamics.
- Present and supervise hands-on educational activities on topics such as marine life, barrier island ecology, rip currents, and salt marsh functionality.

- Lead daily surf lessons, ensuring all campers understand and practice ocean safety, surf etiquette, and wave riding techniques.

- Current certifications in Lifeguarding, CPR, and First Aid (must be valid at the start of staff training).
- ❖ Must be in excellent physical condition and able to lift 50 lbs unassisted.
- ❖ Ability to pass a **500-yard open-ocean swim test**.
- Strong communication, decision-making, and organizational skills.
- No conflicting summer commitments, including travel, work, or other leave of absence.
- ❖ Able to pass a government background check and possess a clean driving record.
- ❖ Ability to work long hours while maintaining high energy and stamina.

- Pursuing or earned a BA or BS in marine biology, environmental science, education, recreation, or related field
- 2 years surfing experience
- ❖ Familiarity with southeastern marine ecosystems and organisms
- Previous experience working in an overnight summer camp setting
- Environmental education certification or teaching credential
