Marine Science & Surf Instruction

- Lead hands-on educational activities focused on marine science topics such as wave dynamics, ocean safety, surf etiquette, rip currents, barrier island ecology, and salt marsh functionality.
- Provide surf lessons and ocean safety instruction to campers, ensuring they develop confidence and learn safe
- Teach campers about coastal ecosystems, marine life, and conservation efforts to inspire environmental stewardship.

Camper Supervision & Safety

- Provide 24-hour supervision of campers in bunk rooms and during field activities, ensuring their safety and well-being.
- Administer medication and monitor dietary preferences for campers as needed.
- Serve as a positive role model, displaying maturity, responsibility, and flexibility in all camper interactions.
- Oversee camper behavior, addressing any discipline issues and ensuring a respectful, fun environment for all participants.
- Safely transport campers in 15-passenger vans to and from activities and excursions.

Current certifications in Lifeguarding, CPR, and First Aid (must be valid at the start of staff training).
Must be in excellent physical condition and able to lift 50 lbs unassisted.
Strong communication, decision-making, and organizational skills.
Clean driving record and ability to pass a government background check.
No conflicting summer commitments, including travel, work, or other leave of absence.

Master's in Marine Biology, Environmental Science, Education, or related field.
Wilderness First Responder certification or higher.
Familiarity with southeastern marine ecosystems and organisms.
Previous experience in a camp setting, particularly in teaching or leadership roles.
