Unit Leader

Overview

Surf Camp, Inc. is looking for an energetic, service-oriented Unit Leader to join our Carolina Ocean Odyssey overnight camp. This position provides a unique opportunity to inspire and educate campers, ages 10-12, while immersing them in the world of ocean safety, surfing, and marine science. As a Unit Leader, you will play a pivotal role in delivering a life-changing ocean experience, fostering environmental stewardship, and creating a supportive, educational environment for both campers and staff.

This role requires a highly organized, detail-oriented team player with strong leadership skills. You will oversee the implementation of daily activities, manage staff, and ensure that the program runs smoothly and safely. You will also provide 24-hour supervision for campers, ensuring their well-being and delivering a fun and impactful experience. This position reports to the Site Director and Program Coordinator.

What You'll Do:

Leadership & Supervision:

- Lead and manage a team of counselors, providing guidance, feedback, and support to ensure a safe, engaging environment for campers.
- Ensure 24-hour supervision of campers both in the bunk rooms and during activities.
- Mentor staff and address any performance issues, fostering a positive and collaborative camp culture.
- Make decisions quickly based on camper needs, weather, and wave conditions.

Program & Curriculum Management:

- Implement and oversee the camp curriculum, ensuring that all activities are educational, engaging, and aligned with Surf Camp's core values of Safety, Learning, and Fun.
- Lead and supervise hands-on educational activities such as wave dynamics, ocean safety, surf etiquette, rip currents, barrier island ecology, and salt marsh functionality.
- Develop and implement activities that combine surf lessons with marine science education to deepen campers' connection to the ocean.

Logistics & Equipment Management:

- Manage the daily setup and breakdown of camp activities, ensuring equipment is prepared, maintained, and ready for use.
- Oversee the organization and inventory of camp supplies and equipment, ensuring that everything is in working order.
- Safely transport campers to and from activities using 15-passenger vans.

Camper Care & Safety:

- Ensure that all campers are safe and feel supported, both physically and emotionally, throughout the program.
- Oversee medication administration, dietary preferences, and special needs to ensure individual campers are properly cared for.
- Manage camper behavior and enforce camp policies to maintain a positive, respectful, and fun camp environment.

Team Collaboration & Communication:

- Facilitate daily team meetings to discuss camper issues, schedule changes, and logistics.
- Maintain open communication with leadership and fellow staff to address any issues and ensure the program runs smoothly.
- Communicate professionally with campers' parents during check-in, check-out, and throughout the camp session, providing updates and addressing concerns.

Responsibilities:

- Lead and supervise surf lessons, ensuring all campers understand and practice ocean safety, surf etiquette, and wave riding techniques.
- Supervise all camp activities, ensuring campers are safe, engaged, and learning throughout the day.

- Coordinate and ensure smooth camper arrival, check-in, and departure processes.
- Manage the setup and breakdown of camp activities and ensure equipment is organized and ready.
- Safely transport campers to off-site activities and excursions.
- Manage camper behavior, enforcing camp rules and providing appropriate discipline when necessary.
- Maintain a positive, inclusive atmosphere where campers feel safe, valued, and engaged.
- Complete all administrative tasks, including preparing supplies, reviewing camp binders, and conducting evaluations.

Skills & Qualifications

Requirements:

- At least 21 years of age with a BA or BS in Marine Biology, Environmental Science, Education, Recreation, or related field (or equivalent experience).
- **3+ years** of ocean wave riding experience and a solid understanding of surfing fundamentals.
- Ability to pass a **500-yard open-ocean swim test**.
- Lifeguarding, CPR, and First Aid certifications (must be valid at the start of staff training).
- Must be in excellent physical condition and able to lift **50 lbs** unassisted.
- Proven experience in marine science or environmental education.
- Strong organizational, communication, decision-making, and logistical skills.
- Able to pass a government background check and have a clean driving record.
- No conflicting summer commitments, including travel, work, or other leave of absence.

Preferred:

- Masters in marine biology, environmental science, education, or related field
- Wilderness First Responder Certification
- Surfing experience
- Familiarity with local marine ecosystems and organisms
- Previous experience working in a camp setting
- Environmental education certification or teaching credential
