Teen Travel Camp Counselor/ Instructor

Overview:

This position reports to the Unit Leader.

Leadership & Supervision

- Provide 24-hour supervision of campers, both in accommodations and during activities.
- Lead a team of counselors, ensuring tasks are delegated effectively and everyone is focused on camper safety and program goals.
- Serve as a positive role model for campers and staff, exhibiting responsibility, flexibility, and maturity.
- Mentor staff members and provide constructive feedback to maintain a high-quality, safe experience for everyone.

Surf Instruction & Program Delivery

- Lead daily surf lessons and provide instruction on ocean safety, surf etiquette, and surf techniques.
- ❖ Develop and implement engaging educational activities, focusing on marine science, cultural exchange, and environmental stewardship.
- Supervise all activities and ensure they align with the camp's educational goals of safety, learning, and fun.

Logistics & Equipment Management

- ❖ Assist with all logistical aspects of camp, including setup and breakdown of activities and camp locations.
- Maintain and manage equipment inventory, ensuring all gear is in good condition and ready for use.
- Safely transport campers in 15-passenger vans to activities and excursions.
- Work closely with vendors and partners to provide an enriching and authentic local cultural experience for campers.

Camper Care & Safety

- Manage camper behavior, ensuring a positive and respectful camp environment.
- Oversee camper safety during all activities and handle any emergency situations that arise.
- * Administer medication and monitor dietary preferences for campers, ensuring individual needs are met.

- Minimum of 3 years of surfing experience and broad knowledge of surfing fundamentals.
- ❖ Ability to pass a 500-yard open-ocean swim test and be in excellent physical condition.
- Current certifications in Lifeguarding, CPR, and First Aid.
- Proven ability to manage staff, work collaboratively, and lead by example.
- ❖ Experience in marine science, environmental education, or summer camp counseling.
- ❖ No conflicting summer commitments (travel, work, etc.).
- Valid passport for international travel and ability to work in the U.S. and abroad.
- Clean driving record and ability to pass a government background check.

Preferred:

- Master's degree in Marine Biology, Environmental Science, Education, or related field.
- Wilderness First Responder certification.
- Fluency in Spanish or other foreign languages.
- Previous experience as a trip leader, in a camp setting, or in an international program.
- Environmental education certification or teaching credential.
- Strong communication, organizational, and problem-solving skills.
